5 Ways to Save

1] Smart Irrigation Controller

A smart controller is like a thermostat for your landscape. It uses weather data to water the landscape only when needed.

2] Drip Irrigation

With drip irrigation, you can save water by watering trees, shrubs, planter beds and even turf, right at the roots.

3] Swap Out Your Sprinklers

Fix broken or clogged spray heads, and update old sprinklers with more efficient spray or rotor nozzles.

4] Rain/Freeze or Soil Moisture Sensor

A sensor placed in the soil or on your property can prevent your system from watering in the rain, during freezes and when the soil is still moist.

5] Reduce Water Needs

Permeable pavers and synthetic turf can reduce your water requirements. Soil amendments can also help you conserve water by improving soil quality.
